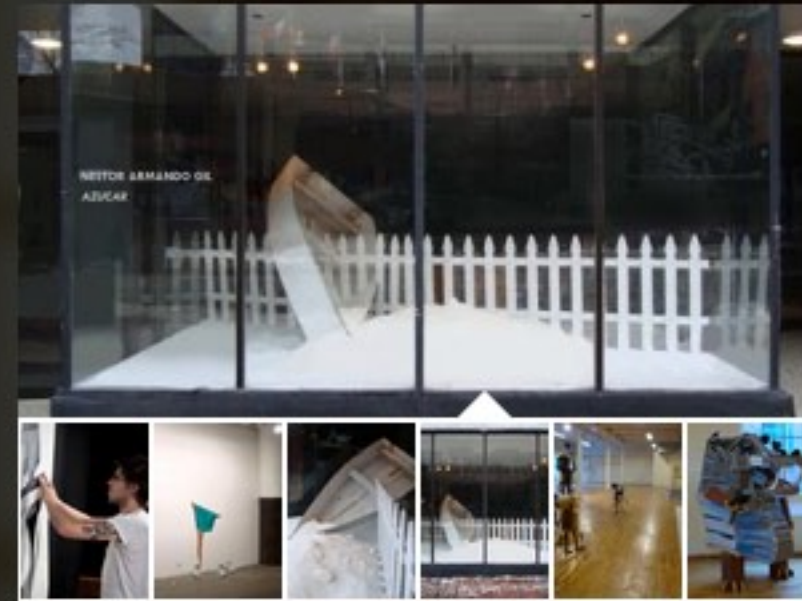

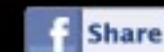
Coleman Burke Gallery Showcases the Maine/NYC Contemporary Art Connection
